

## Present Simple



- ▶ Something, that is always true
- ▶ Daily routines
- ▶ Something that happens regularly

### positive statements

I	eat
you	eat
he	<b>eats</b>
she	<b>eats</b>
it	<b>eats</b>
we	eat
you	eat
they	eat



### negative statements

I	don't	eat
you	don't	eat
he	<b>doesn't</b>	eat
she	<b>doesn't</b>	eat
it	<b>doesn't</b>	eat
we	don't	eat
you	don't	eat
they	don't	eat

<b>does</b>	he	eat ?
<b>does</b>	she	eat ?
<b>does</b>	it	eat ?
do	we	eat ?
do	you	eat ?
do	they	eat ?

## Present Continuous



- ▶ Something, that is just happening
- ▶ Something that is true only now or about now
- ▶ Describing pictures

### positive statements

I	<b>am</b>	<u>eating</u>
you	<b>are</b>	<u>eating</u>
he	<b>is</b>	<u>eating</u>
she	<b>is</b>	<u>eating</u>
it	<b>is</b>	<u>eating</u>
we	<b>are</b>	<u>eating</u>
you	<b>are</b>	<u>eating</u>
they	<b>are</b>	<u>eating</u>

### negative statements

I	<b>m' not</b>	<u>eating</u>
you	<b>aren't</b>	<u>eating</u>
he	<b>isn't</b>	<u>eating</u>
she	<b>isn't</b>	<u>eating</u>
it	<b>isn't</b>	<u>eating</u>
we	<b>aren't</b>	<u>eating</u>
you	<b>aren't</b>	<u>eating</u>
they	<b>aren't</b>	<u>eating</u>
